We had contracted with GCS to help us perform some energy effeciencies in our 1930's home in East Atlanta. In their findings they were able to determine that our house was pretty null on being efficient. We knew there was no insulation in the upstairs which made things worse but they performed an initial audit to find out exactly what needed to be done and help out with any rebates offered by the city and power companys. Shane Matteson was our contact and the following was identified to help us reach our maximum effeciencies.1. Install High Quality weatherstripping and door sweeps on leaky doors2. Installed open cell sprayfoam insulation along entire roofline and gables.3. Installed closed cell insulation along the subfloors4. Caulk and seal around all fireplaces and leaky windows5. Seal off plumbing penetrations under sinks and toilets with expanding foam6. Clear caulk along bottom of baseboards on exterior walls7. Install insulated water heater blanket over tank and pipes8. Use metal tape to seal around all supply and registers in home.9. Use tape and mastic to seal all supply line takeoffs to plenums on both systems to maximize efficiency of ductwork.10. Upgrade incandescent bulbs to CFL or LED

Making all of these improvements have made a huge difference in comforts and utility bills. We made all of these changes. Shane worked with us on obtaining about \$4000.00 in rebates bringing our total cost under what we budgeted which was about \$7K. In July 2011our electric bill was close to \$700.00 for the month. They sprayed Open Cell foam 5.5 inches deep in the roof line. This included Flashing the 2 X 6 rafters to seal in the airtight thermal seal.

Member Comments:

Jameson came to my house and rental house to do estimates for Spray foam. He was very knowledgable and answered all my questions. Sometimes even late into the evening. He helped me understand the different types of installations and value including fire suppression. I was sold.

Alex (Shooter) and Juan (Support) came to my house on time and ready to work. You can tell these guys are pro's. They laid out the planned installation and got started. My house is a complicated roofline with many turns and twists. This barely slowed them down. I can't believe how quickly Alex worked with the Hot Georgia sun beating down on the roof. It must be 165 degrees up there. Please be careful of your workers while they are on the Job site. Bring them lots of ice water. They will be very greatful. It is also customary for the shooter to take several breaks to get out of the heat. Its built into the price of the installation so don't worry. You want your shooter to have his head clear. This is very hard work. Think Gymnast with a Gas Mask.

Both Alex and Juan were trustworthy and I left them alone in my home. You don't want to be in the house while they are shooting. The smell is not good.

Open windows helps remove the fumes.

I definately noticed how quite the house is to outside noises. I live on an airport and the airplane noise is definately reduced. The thermal properties were definately enhanced but it will remain warm in the Attic for a while. The spray gun puts out a lot of heat and your new thermal barrier will hold onto it until your air conditioner has a chance to get ride of it thru the ceiling.

Juan cleaned up the house after they were done. Nice job.

I would definately use GCS Spray foam again. I will leave my name and number with Jameson as a reference. Job well done.
